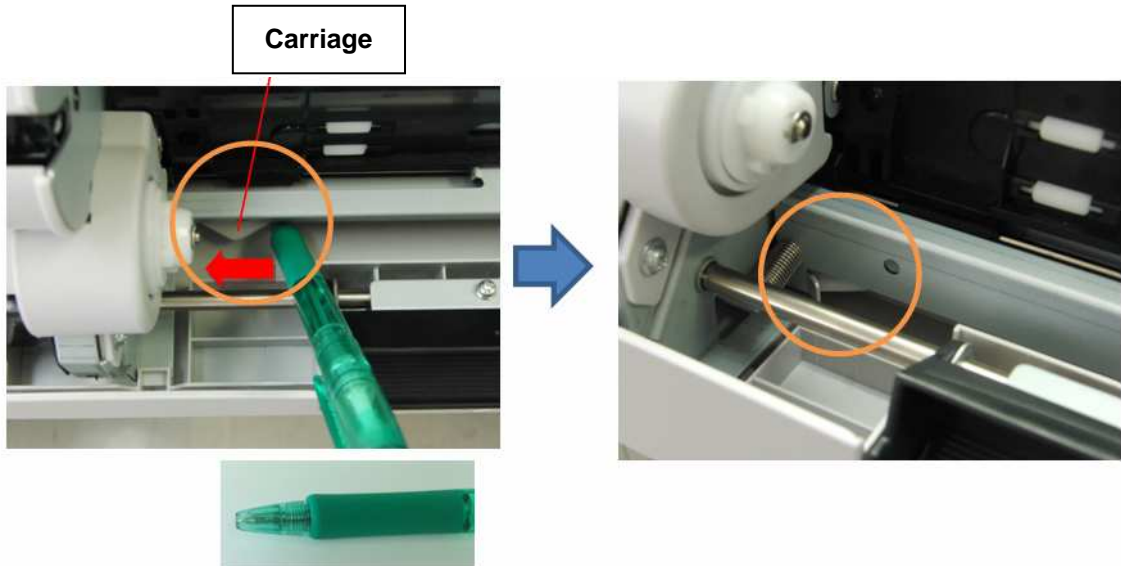
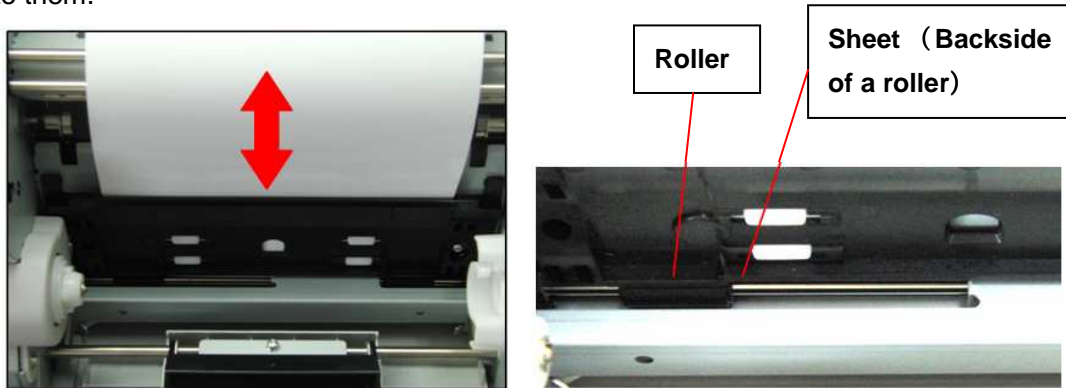


How to prevent a new printer from paper jamming at initialization

1. Move the carriage of a cutter by using a soft stick, such as a plastic stick, to the position as indicated by the images below, in order to let a paper pass to a paper guide.



2. Set a paper roll and insert the paper farther into a paper guide, move it up-and-down and remove the rubber rollers from the sheets, which are just backsides of the rollers and might be stuck to them.



3. Confirm if the top of the paper comes out from a front cover.



4. Set a paper roll and ribbon, turn on the printer and check if the initialization finishes without paper jamming.
